ATTENTION!! SPECIAL MESSAGES FROM THE ACTIVITY COMMITTEE

A formal complaint has been sent to the Activity Committee about reserving tables at Activity Events, such as dances and dinners. This situation does not promote the positive vibe we strive to achieve here at HRVR. The practice of reserving tables first started by reserving a table for the cooks and servers, and then the decorating crew started reserving tables for themselves and their friends. Then, people started coming to the Activity Center in the afternoon to reserve tables. As you can see, this practice soon became out of hand.

The Activity Committee has decided that all scheduled events will have an open seating and a first-come, first-served policy. The doors to the Event Room will remain closed until half an hour before the event starts. At that time, you are welcome to go ahead and claim your table. From this day forward, the policy will be that no reserved cards or any personal items will be allowed on tables before the doors open. On a positive note, you might meet new friends and experience a different view from sitting at a new location. We want an inclusive, not exclusive, feeling here at the best RV Resort around. Please abide by these guidelines.

ACTIVITY PASSES, ETC.

- 1. Activity Passes are NON-TRANSFERRABLE... this means only the persons whose name(s) are on the pass, may use the pass. You are only hurting the Activity Committee by not adhering to this rule.
- 2. Activity Passes will go on sale November 1st, 2025 for \$40 per person, or \$80 per couple. This will include entry into at least three (3) parties with outside bands. You may leave a check (no date) with office staff prior to leaving for the summer; your pass will be available December 1st.
- 3. We will extend Activity Pass sales through January, but the cost will be the same. It will not be pro-rated if you miss any of the events.
- 4. ON A SIDE NOTE... The Activity Committee only charges for events that we need to cover the expenses for -band, food supplies, etc. If an event fails to make a profit, there will be consideration to not host the event again. EXAMPLE: If you had some free martinis because you failed to use one of your tickets, or if you used a Raffle ticket to purchase a martini, you are only taking away from the monies needed to cover the expense of the event. For the martini party, we had 303 tickets submitted; but ran out of 400 plus martini glasses, that is approximately a \$500+ loss for the event.

If you want to participate but do not have an SXS, there is a passenger sign-up sheet also.










Recap of the Martini Party
